This is a private transaction between the buyer and the seller for the purchase of a French Bull Dog. The Following are the terms and conditions of this contract.

Section #1

**Price of the Dog.** (1) the buyer agrees to the purchase of a French Bulldog/Frenchtion Puppy for the amount of (USD) \$\_\_\_\_\_. (2) A **\$500** deposit to Bank of America, Western Union or through Zelle will reserve a puppy. Deposits are NON-Refundable. There are no refunds once the puppy has been reserved, either partial or full. In the event you do not return a signed copy of the contract, the buyer acknowledges that the action of putting down a deposit/transfer of funds electronically will automatically enter the buyer into a contractual agreement of the terms herein. The Balance is due in cash or through Zelle at delivery of the puppy. (3) The seller includes delivery to a neutral safe location within in 150 miles of Roanoke, VA. The buyer is responsible for any Nanny fees based upon location should the delivery be necessary for a further distance. Puppies will never be shipped. (4) Every effort will be made by the seller to assure that the puppy is healthy when it is delivered to the buyer. The buyer is responsible for all medical expenses incurred from date of delivery.

Section #2

**Identifying information for the French Bulldog Puppy:** (1) The seller agrees to deliver to the buyer a puppy with the following characteristics:

### Section #3

**Health of the Puppy:** (1) The seller guarantees that the puppy has been certified as healthy by a licensed veterinarian and is up to date on all vaccinations and deworming for its age with no symptoms of infection or contagious disease. (2) The buyer must take the dog to a veterinarian for a complete physical examination and health certification within 4 days of receiving the puppy. The cost of the examination will be paid by the buyer. If the buyer does not take the puppy to a veterinarian within 4 days, this warranty is void. The seller must be notified immediately if a problem exists in the results of the veterinary examination. If the veterinarian finds the dog to be a poor health risk or detects any physical health problems that would require further veterinary care, the buyer must notify the seller IMMEDIATELY. A report of the results from the veterinary must be emailed to the seller within 24 hours. The seller's veterinarian will verify the results.

### Section #4

**Health Warranty.** The puppy will be guaranteed for six months from date of delivery against any life threatening defects. This includes severe hip dysplasia which requires surgery to correct. It also covers kidney, heart, pancreases, spine, and liver problems of severe life threatening nature. If the puppy is found to have a life threatening defect, a complete report from the buyer's veterinarian must be emailed to the seller within 48 hours after the determination. If the puppy dies within six month period, the buyer will pay for a necropsy to ascertain the reason for death. If the reason is congenital, the seller will replace the puppy with one of the same value, to be determined by the seller. A replacement puppy may not be available immediately. The buyer will wait until a puppy from a future litter is available. The buyer is responsible for all shipping expenses to and from the seller on a replacement puppy. A monetary amount up to the purchase price will be made at the seller's discretion for purposes of medical care to be determined by the seller and seller's veterinarian. Seller will not cover general veterinarian bills. The health guarantee is not valid if the dog has been sold or transferred to a new owner. If the pup in your care has been treated for an injury the contract is null and void for that injury.

### Section #5

**Health Conditions:** The health guarantee does not cover afflictions that are considered common for bulldog breeds. These include the following: Treatment for internal or external parasites or bacteria, cherry eye, loose hips, loose knees, skin allergies, elongated soft palette and small or collapsed nostrils, bad or uneven bites, undescended testicles, Demodex, mange, inguinal or umbilical hernias, fleas, ticks, ear mites, coccidia, kennel cough, Giardia, campylobacter and thyroid dysfunction these issues are not life threatening and can be remedied quickly. The seller does not assume responsibility for any reaction to any vaccination.

### Section #6:

**Puppy Care:** (1) the buyer agrees to provide the puppy with routine preventative care and follow veterinarian guidelines for vaccination and deworming. (2) the buyer agrees to keep the puppy away from dog parks, grassy areas, pet stores, etc. until the puppy

is at least 16 weeks of age and has received final vaccinations. (3) the buyer agrees to keep the puppy away from lakes, rivers, oceans, and other water where the puppy can be in danger of drowning unless proper safety protocol is followed. (4) the buyer agrees to provide adequate fresh water, quality food and rest to the puppy. (5) the buyer assumes responsibility for protecting the puppy from loss, theft, danger, neglect, injury and abuse.

Section #7

**Return Policy.** (1) a puppy eligible for replacement, pursuant to section 4 of this contract must be returned or euthanized with prior permission from the seller to qualify for replacement. (2) the returned puppy must appear in good condition to the seller, other than the specified problems. (3) A puppy will not be eligible for replacement if it has been or appears to have been neglected, abused, or euthanized without prior permission from the seller. (4) the buyer agrees to assume financial responsibility for all the transportation cost incurred for transporting the puppy to the seller.

Section #8

There is no guarantee or warranty that the buyer will be able to show or breed the puppy, regardless of show or breeding potential at the time of purchase. There is no money back if you, the buyer decides the pup isn't to your liking.

Pups left 6 weeks past pickup date whether paid or not paid will forfeit all money paid to date. Puppy is sold with as pet only.

Section #9

**Dispute:**(1) This is the entire purchase contract: no other promise or stipulations are included or implied in this sale. (2) In any and all legal action pertaining to this dog, this contract shall be considered to be legally binding. (3) in the event of any dispute or disagreement under this contract, the Buyer understands that this contract is under the jurisdiction of the Commonwealth of VA, in the County of Botetourt. It is agreed that the place of venue shall be Botetourt County, VA.

**Bringing your Frenchton Puppy Home:**

Your new puppy should adjust to his or her new home in a few days.

With the stress of a new environment, puppies are often at high risk for Coccidia and Giardia.

These are treatable. They are brought by the stress of travel, a new home, new water and food, new people, and change of climate or surroundings. All puppies are treated for Coccidiosis and Giardia before they leave us. Preventive treatment however is not a guarantee the puppy will not have the above issues. If they don't, they are rarely serious and should be diagnosed and treated by a licensed Vet if symptoms persist for several days. Both parasites are easily treated. We do not cover treatment for the either.

Giardia is a ubiquitous parasite and can be found everywhere, in puddles of water, the grass, dirt, or having the puppy outdoors or in a public places prior to their third set of vaccines! Also, if additional family pets are in the home, they can be carriers and I recommend getting a stool sample checked by your vet after you get your puppy home. If your puppy does have loose stools make sure your vet also does a direct smear to look for an overload of bacteria, as this can also be a cause of loose stools
